HOW TO FILE A CLAIM

File at www.va.gov and follow the instructions for filing a claim for disability compensation.

CLAIM WORDING EXAMPLE

I am filing a claim under U.S.C. II5I for anxiety and depression caused by Covid-I9 vaccine coercion and inadequate informed consent at a VA facility. This mental distress directly stems from the pressures and lack of proper information provided during the vaccination process.

Mental conditions secondary to vaccine coercion may include but are not limited to:

- Anxiety Disorders
 Increased anxiety, particularly health-related.
- Depression

Feelings of helplessness and lack of control.

• Stress-Related Disorders

General stress and related symptoms due to coercion experience
