UNOPPOSED MOTION OF NON-PARTY ELEVANCE HEALTH FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO MOVE TO QUASH OR LIMIT SUBPOENA DUCES TECUM

Non-party Elevance Health ("Elevance"), by and through its undersigned counsel, files this motion pursuant to Rules 3.22, 3.34(c), and 4.3(b) of the FTC's Rules of Practice for Adjudicative Proceedings to extend the time to move to quash or limit the subpoena *duces tecum* (the "Subpoena") served by Respondents Express Scripts, Inc., Evernorth Health, Inc., Medco Health Services, Inc., and Ascent Health Services LLC (collectively "ESI Respondents") on December 31, 2024. Counsel for ESI Respondents does not oppose the requested relief.

On December 31, 2024, counsel for ESI Respondents served its subpoena on Elevance, with a return date of January 18, 2025. On January 1, 2025, counsel for ESI Respondents represented via email that ESI Respondents would consolidate discussions on the scope of its subpoena with other respondents in this matter.

Elevance requests an extension of the deadline to move to quash or limit the Subpoena until February 10, 2025, so that Elevance can continue negotiating with ESI Respondents in an effort to potentially narrow or limit the scope of the Subpoena. The proposed order granting the extension is attached to this motion.

This motion does not waive Elevance's right to seek further extension of the deadline in the future.

[PROPOSED] ORDER GRANTING UNOPPOSED MOTION OF NON-PARTY ELEVANCE HEALTH FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO MOVE TO QUASH OR LIMIT SUBPOENA DUCES TECUM

On January 6, 2025, Elevance Health ("Elevance") filed an unopposed joint motion to extend its time to move to quash or limit the subpoena for production of documents served by Respondents Express Scripts, Inc., Evernorth Health, Inc., Medco Health Services, Inc., and Ascent Health Services LLC (collectively "ESI Respondents") on December 31, 2024.

Under FTC Rule 3.34(c), any motion to limit or quash a subpoena must be filed within ten days of receipt of the subpoena. 16 C.F.R. § 3.34(c). The Administrative Law Judge may extend any time limit prescribed by the rules "[f]or good cause shown." 16 C.F.R. § 4.3(b).

Elevance has demonstrated good cause for the extension requested in the motion. Counsel for Elevance has conducted an initial meet-and-confer with counsel for ESI Respondents concerning the response to the subpoena, and Elevance states that the extension will allow Elevance to continue negotiating the Subpoena. Accordingly, the unopposed motion is

GRANTED, and it is hereby ORDERED that Elevance's deadline for filing any motion to quash or limit the Subpoena is extended to February 10, 2025.
