Senator Mills appointed to the Committee on Revenue and Fiscal Affairs

BATON ROUGE – State Senator Fred H. Mills, Jr., R-New Iberia, has been appointed by Senate President Page Cortez, to serve as a member of the Committee on Revenue and Fiscal Affairs. Senator Mills, who has worked closely with the Joint Legislative Committee on Capital Outlay, has played a pivotal role in securing funding for important projects impacting Iberia Parish. During the recent 2022 Legislative Session, Senator Mills worked closely with Capital Outlay leadership, Chairman Bret Allain and Chairman Stuart Bishop, President Cortez, and Senator Hensgens, along with Representative Beau Beaulieu of New Iberia to secure critical funding for the Port of Iberia Acadiana Gulf of Mexico Access Channel (AGMAC), deepening the channel to allow for larger vessels to access the port.

Senator Mills said, “It is an honor to be appointed to the Revenue and Fiscal Affairs Committee, I have worked alongside my fellow legislators to put our state’s funding and resources where they are most needed. I have enjoyed working with the Chairman of these committees, their members and their staff this past session to fund critical projects for our area.”

Capital Outlay Chairman, Senator Bret Allain, said, “Senator Mills’ leadership and concern for the citizens of Iberia Parish shows through his work in acquiring the monies needed to complete area projects.”
