**LEGISLATIVE AFFAIRS** Provides for temporary successors for legislators called to active duty in the armed forces

**LEGISLATORS** (Constitutional Amendment) Requires the legislature to provide for temporary successors for legislators ordered to active duty

**INSURANCE/HEALTH** Limits retroactive denial and recoupment of health insurance claims

**CORPORATIONS** Changes the name of the First Stop Shop to the office of geauxbiz within the Department of State

**CHILDREN/CARE** Provides procedures for child in need of care proceedings

**INSURANCE/PROPERTY** Provides that the 10% surcharge on rates charged by the La. Citizens Property Insurance Corp. shall not apply in St. Mary Parish
