James Quinn is in his 9th year as the Chief of Staff for Senator Bill Cassidy (R-LA). Quinn is a graduate of Tulane University and Loyola University School of Law. In 2006, after serving as senior advisor, Quinn was named the Executive Director of the Republican Party of Louisiana. In 2008, Quinn moved on to become the Director of Boards and Commissions for the Office of the Governor. There he provided research and advised the governor on all gubernatorial appointments to state and federal boards and commissions.



Shortly following his election to the US House of Representatives, Dr. Cassidy named Quinn his Chief of Staff, a position he held through two successful reelections to the US House of Representatives. In 2014, after his election to the U.S. Senate, Senator Cassidy named Quinn his Chief of Staff. He is also a former Adjunct Instructor at LSU where he taught Constitutional Law.
