# **Testing Requirements**

Commercial applicators must pass the General Standards and at least 1 category specific exam. All exams are administered only at LDAF offices. <u>Pesticide & Environmental Programs</u>

### **Requirements to Take Test**

Applicator License (Core): must complete application and provide ID

**Commercial Certification:** Must complete application and provide ID. Categories 7c1,2,3 and 8d require proof of experience.

**How frequently do you have to retest (if at all?):** Commercial applicators must recertify every 3 years be either retesting or attending an in-person approved training.

**Business License Required:** Yes for any business charging a fee for the application of pesticides must get on owner0operator license from LDAF each year

# **Continuing Education**

LDAF does not count CEU's. In-person trainings must be pre-approved and last at least 6 hours (not including lunch or breaks)
