Four months into the year we should be around 33% in our programs.

The new safety contract has been approved and we should have this contract spent by December.

We need to spend aproximately 50k in costs in our programs combined to stay on budget for the year.

We are on track and where we need to be through October. Not including safety we are at 32% year to date.
