Single Pharmacy Benefits Manager (PBM) for Medicaid Managed Care

Starting October 1, 2023, Magellan Medicaid Administration Inc. will process all Medicaid managed care organization (MCO) pharmacy claims.

New policies as of October 1, 2023

The following new pharmacy policies will be implemented October 1, 2023. LDH will post provider notices with details of each policy here:

• Reimburse pharmacies for counseling for vaccines with administration of the vaccine when criteria is met and billing is appropriate.

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- Change clotting factor reimbursement to an average acquisition cost per unit and a dispensing fee per unit dispensed. Clotting factor will be limited to pharmacy claims only.
- One dispensing fee for a 30-day supply of maintenance drugs for MCO claims.
- Change the maximum allowed professional dispensing fee from \$10.99 to \$11.81 for all Fee-for-Service claims and MCO local pharmacy claims.
- LDH will add diabetic supplies to the Medicaid Single Preferred Drug List to have one list of preferred/non-preferred products. As of December 1, 2023, diabetic supplies will be limited to pharmacy claims only.

Medicaid Provider Enrollment Portal Requirements

The Medicaid Provider Portal enrollment initiative was implemented July 1, 2023.

All providers including pharmacies, pharmacists, prescribers and facilities that render services to Medicaid beneficiaries based on order, prescription or referral will not be paid for such items or services, as of July 1, 2023, unless the provider enrolls in the Medicaid portal and the provider's NPI is included on the claim submitted to Medicaid by the rendering provider (42 CFR 455.440).

Please note that this extends to pharmacy Point of Sale (POS) systems as well. If either the prescribing provider (or vaccinating pharmacist) and/or the pharmacy provider are **not** enrolled in the portal, then the pharmacy claim will deny beginning July 1, 2023.

Any providers who have not completed enrollment by June 30, 2023 will have their patients assigned to another primary care physician and will be terminated from the program.

The Affordable Care Act requires that some entities/businesses enrolling or reenrolling in Louisiana Medicaid pay a fee to cover the cost of screening. Entities/businesses that are currently enrolled in Medicare or Medicaid in another state are exempt. If your application is received and you are required to pay a fee, you will receive a letter detailing the fee requirement and how to pay. The fee must be received before your application can be approved.
