### **ELIGIBLE APPLICANTS**

Proposers shall meet the following criteria:

- A physical office location in Kentucky with key staff available to attend in-person meetings in Louisville, Kentucky and potentially other sites as they are established.
- Experience obtaining approvals to conduct evaluations through an IRB.
- The evaluation team must have a member with minimum of five (5) years of experience designing and implementing performance evaluation measurement (to include qualitative and quantitative measures), and conducting applied research or evaluation projects at agencies implementing restorative justice practices.

### **DESCRIPTION**

Volunteers of America Mid-States Restorative Justice (VOA RJ) is seeking to contract with an evaluator to design and conduct an evaluation of Restorative Justice projects including justice-involved youth and adults and school projects. This evaluation will focus on: a) project implementation b) project effectiveness; and c) (to the extent possible) relationship between implementation and effectiveness.

The goal of the evaluation is to: 1) determine success rates of the individuals referred, 2) satisfaction of restorative justice practice participants,3) to the extend possible recognize what practices were most effective in referred individual's success and participant satisfaction, 4) to the extent possible identify essential components to implementing the VOA RJ program leading to client success.

The evaluation findings will serve two primary purposes: 1) aiding in sustaining components and practices in existing projects contributing to client satisfaction and client success; and 2) aiding in guiding implementation in new sites. Evaluation findings will also be used to inform VOA RJ activities, such as enhancing trainings and educational material for key stakeholders, including but not limited to restorative practices and case management processes.
