

# **Year 1 Summary Report to Advisory Board Members**

September 12, 2018

Thanks for participating on the Mountain Plains ATTC Advisory Board. We are 11 months into the MPATTC efforts and are pleased to share some of our Year 1 achievements.

### **Advisory Board Feedback**

The following three themes emerged as a result of discussions and activities conducted at the Advisory Board meeting on December 7, 2017 in Denver:

- 1. Importance of integrated care focus
- 2. Expanded training and education on evidence-based practices
- 3. Use of technology to enhance services

These priority areas have been used to inform Year 1 training and technical assistance events to date. For example, Enhanced Professional Learning Series (EPLS) on SBIRT, MI, Skill-based Videoconferencing (SbVC), and Technology-based Clinical Supervision (TBCS) have been conducted throughout the Region.

#### **Needs Assessment Data**

A Needs Assessment Survey was conducted in March 2018. In general, between 90-95% of respondents indicated it was *important* or *extremely important* that they receive training and/or technical assistance on:

- 1. Trauma-informed care (95.38%)
- 2. Co-occurring disorders (92.85%)
- 3. Support for recovery and crisis stabilization (91.99%)
- 4. Strategies to reduce stigma toward individuals with SUD (90.76%)
- 5. Suicide assessment and prevention (90.76%)

Results will be discussed at the meeting and state-specific reports are forthcoming.

### **Training Provided**

- 1. Enhanced Professional Learning Series (EPLS) are structured online learning opportunities that include an introductory webinar, online group skill-building sessions, and online group performance evaluation/consultation. EPLs were provided in all six Region 8 states, with participation open in several cases to any provider in the Region regardless of which state she/he resides/practices. EPL topics offered to date include:
  - Colorado Skills-based Videoconferencing for Behavioral Health Professionals
  - Montana Technology-based Clinical Supervision
  - North Dakota Motivational Interviewing for Behavioral Health Professionals
  - South Dakota ASAM Integration for Behavioral Health Professionals
  - Utah Screening, Brief Intervention, and Referral to Treatment (SBIRT)
  - Wyoming ASAM Integration for Behavioral Health Professionals
- 2. Mountain Plains ATTC was invited to send participants to the *Family Centered Behavioral Support for Pregnant and Postpartum Women* event sponsored by Region 7.

# **University of Wyoming Project ECHO Sessions**

- Provided/sponsored speakers for the Opioid-Specific ECHO Sessions
- Did an ECHO session on August 29<sup>th</sup> in collaboration with Recover Wyoming on using technology to enhance recovery support services

#### **Technical Assistance**

Most states in Region 8 requested MPATTC assistance on a variety of topics. Listed below are several examples of technical assistance provided in the Region and one international opportunity.

- Montana billing and structure for psychoeducational/process groups for providers; Consultation regarding Residential ASAM Level 3 providers
- North Dakota alternative response for mothers with substance use disorders during pregnancy and immediately post-partum
- South Dakota survey development and continuum of care to expand treatment and recovery for the Great Plains Tribal Epidemiology Center
- Utah responded to a request for *Skill-Based Video Conferencing* for counselors working in the Juvenile Justice system. Date is pending.
- Kiev, Ukraine provided intensive technical assistance for four program components

#### **GPRA Measurement**

As shown on the tables included as Attachment A, the Year 1 proposed targets to date for events (18) and participants (357) have been exceeded (27 events completed and 364 participants served), resulting in 150% and 102% coverage rates respectively as of September 5, 2018. Data collected at these events using the SAMHSA-required GPRA measures indicate that participants rated Mountain Plains ATTC-sponsored training and technical assistance events quite high. Overall, the majority (~90%) of participants were *Very Satisfied* or *Satisfied* with the quality of the event, materials, and information presented; *Strongly Agreed* or *Agreed* that they would recommend the event to a colleague (89.3%); and that the information received was *Very Useful* or *Useful* (93.2%).

# Workgroups

Five workgroups were formed to guide activities, with each state having representation:

- Opioid Treatment Providers
- Behavioral Health Treatment Providers/Treatment Provider Associations
- Health Professions Educators
- Frontier Treatment Providers and Tribal Behavioral Health Treatment Providers
- Recovery Community Organizations

All workgroups will have met at least once prior to the end of Year 1.
