

Dr. Susan Lieberman is Vice President, International Policy, Wildlife Conservation Society; she leads WCS policy engagement in multiple intergovernmental fora. She has worked in international biodiversity conservation, at the science/policy intersection, for more than 30 years, including extensive experience with wildlife trade and trafficking. She has expertise working with treaties and other intergovernmental bodies, including CITES, CBD, and CMS. Previously, she worked for Pew Charitable Trusts, WWF-International, and U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service. She obtained her Ph.D. in tropical ecology and did postdoctoral research at the University of Southern California. She was elected to the IUCN Council in 202; is an appointed member of the United for Wildlife/Royal Foundation Transport Taskforce; and was a member of President Obama's Advisory Council on Wildlife Trafficking.
